## Tennessee Hemp Industries Association Partners with Tennessee Growers to Hold Hemp Maze on Chapel Hill Farm

## First Inaugural Industrial Hemp Maze Will Open to the Public

**Murfreesboro, TN** – On August 20th, Tennessee Hemp Industries Association (TNHIA) in partnership with licensed hemp growers, Sandra Scales, Paige Thompson and Clint Palmer will host the first-ever hemp maze in the state. This unique event will bring the challenge and fun of a traditional crop maze together with a hands-on industrial hemp educational experience. Guests are welcome to come picnic in the shade and relax in the hammock garden. Vendors and sponsors can sign-up (*see www.hempmaze.org for details*) and will be announced in the coming weeks. Participants will be required to complete a review of rules and sign a waiver before entry.
